

# 900kms in one day, in my C4 Picasso



I drove 4,600kms in 19 days – including 900kms in one day – not for the faint-hearted!

Booking in June, for travel in July, meant I didn't get my first choice (Citroën Cactus) but the C4 Picasso petrol manual with GPS took good care of me.

For the geeks records, my average speed was 70km/hr and fuel consumption was 6.2L/100km (about 840km per tank which was pretty good!).

The C4 Picasso was really comfortable and the GPS system was really easy to use - only getting me lost once!



The cruise controls were on the steering wheel, making them really simple to use – as were the sound system controls on the other side. Vision through the zenith windscreen was excellent and the vehicle's handling was more than capable when I took it over the Spluga Pass between Switzerland and Italy.

All went very well at the pick-up and drop-off point in Frankfurt and I look forward to repeating the experience sometime in the future.
